Unfortunately our member who had adequate space for this had to move house before the cat net had been purchased, and no longer had as much space. As a result we purchased two large (rather than one extra large) cat nets, plus one small cat net and associated accessories.

In this instance the cat net is against the glass doors, which are opened during the day to acclimatise the pups to the outdoors. On occasion the cat nets are moved outdoors for a few hours to enable the flying foxes to get some sun exposure. As the cat nets aren't double skinned, we discourage their use outdoors, particularly at night, for fear of rats,
